Dear Customer,

Honeywell Energy & Sustainability Solutions takes its compliance with REACH very seriously.

We have completed the process to identify which, if any, substances of very high concern (SVHCs), (those meeting the criteria set out in Article 57 of REACH and included on the REACH “Candidate List”, are contained in Honeywell’s **products** mentioned hereinafter (see attached list).

As part of this SVHCs identification process we have:

- Reviewed internal/publicly available data in relation to the presence of SVHCs in our products or any of their component parts;
- Reviewed available supplier information for all input materials;
- Reviewed available safety data sheets for all input materials;
- Communicated with selected suppliers.

As a result of this process, Honeywell can state that to the best of our knowledge none of the SVHCs substances are intentionally added to the Honeywell product referenced above and if present would not exceed the concentrations that trigger the regulatory reporting actions. This statement refers to the substances on the **Candidate List as it was disseminated by ECHA in January 2024**.
